People do get themselves into some very dangerous situations, either through carelessness, bravado or ignorance or sometimes just bad luck seemingly, the Coastguard and the RNLI do an incredible job out there in the Seas which can change so rapidly from a slight swell to huge waves which endanger life and limb.

So much of what is happening in our world at the moment can threaten to overwhelm us, the cost of living crisis, the war in Ukraine, the price of fuel, employment , debt, illness, a perfect storm can often feel to be just on the horizon.

I read in the book of Psalms just yesterday in Psalm 107 about those seafarers who were at their wits end in a storm, who were 'staggering and reeling like drunkards' it says, and they cried out 'LORD help me' in their distress.....and it says that 'God calmed the storm to a whisper' and stilled the waves.

Truly for those in the tumult of the sea to be able to alert the Coastguard and have help reach out to them and lead them to a safe harbour is an amazing rescue, to be able to turn to God whether on land or sea and know that he hears your hearts cry and is there for you is also an amazing rescue as the disciple Peter found our when he got into difficulties and was in danger of being swamped by the waves.

God is only a Prayer away for any of us whoever we are and whatever is threatening to overwhelm us , Psalm 107 says...'what a blessing was that stillness when he brought them into safe harbour'.....

Thank you God that you hear our Prayer even from the darkest places.... Even in a another Bible Story from the Belly of a great Fish!

Annual General Meeting – Chair, Caroline Richardson and Vice – Chair, Pauline Topping were re-elected. The Annual Report was presented and unanimously accepted. The Land and Asset Register and Risk and Financial Management Assessment for 2022/2023 were agreed.

The Insurance cover arrangements for 2022/2023 were confirmed.

Wet first half and then fine and warm.

Addingham Sports, Saturday 1st, wet (again!), proceeds given to Cumberland Infirmary.

Mrs J.B. Parker (Gamblesby) presided at the Penrith Women's Liberal Association Garden Fete at Brunswick Hall / Brunswick Square, Thursday 20th, 2.30 pm. It ended with a Dance, 6.30—10.00 pm.

Mr H.H. Barker, farmer, Melmerby, owns a taxi as well. Up in Court for using it for private purposes, and for driving it without a licence—fined 10/- and £1 (now £40 and £80).

On Thursday 6th, the Langwathby Reading Room and May Day Committee held a free social to show the new piano they bought for the Village.

The RDC says that the Langwathby—Little Salkeld Station Road is too narrow for motor charabancs and should be closed to them.



The signposts along the Fellside are now decrepit and rusty. Cumberland C.C. want to merge various primary schools e.g. Edenhall (average 26 pupils) and Langwathby (average 42) - feel it's too far to walk for either.

Ousby's "Grateful" War Memorial window was unveiled on Saturday evening by Major F.C.F. Parker, Kirkoswald and dedicated by the Bishop. Ousby sent its lads to the War; some were wounded, but all came home.

Culgaith Parish Council has got its School a swimming bath (local water).

Mrs Nelson (Langwathby) opened Stainton W.I.'s new tennis court on 24th.

The Hartside road from Penrith to Langwathby was tarred in early August.

Born at Eden View, Culgaith, 2 July, to Mr & Mrs W.H. Wilkinson, a daughter; at Bank House, Culgaith, to Mr & Mrs Frank Burne, a daughter.

Married at St Mary's, Windermere, 6th, James Wilson Crosthwaite of Alice Howe, Windermere to Eleanor (Nellie), eldest daughter of Mrs and the late Mr Robert Thompson of Edenhall.

Died at The Lodge, Gamblesby, 5th, Mary wife of Joseph Morton and elder daughter of John T and Jane Workman, Gamblesby, aged 25, buried at Addingham, Saturday 8th, 2.30 p.m.

What is involved?



You need to give up a weekend twice or, at most, 3 times a year. Articles come on a Friday and Memo needs to be ready for the printer by the following Wednesday. This gives time for the proof-reader to check everything and for any tweaks to be completed. Usually, our typists pass their finished draft to the proof-reader on the Sunday and it's all finished by the Monday.

What skills do you need?

We use Microsoft Publisher (which we'll provide) so you need a Windows computer and a printer. You'll be given the text and some of the images, but you'll be able to be creative with lay-out and clip-art. You will need to be able to use Publisher but we will give you clear guidelines and there will always be someone to call to get advice or guidance, and our proof-readers are brilliant at spotting slip-ups.

No major changes train wise with Monday to Saturday having 7 trains to Leeds and 8 to Carlisle. Sundays however is a bit of a curiosity with 5 trains to Leeds and 6 to Carlisle, however until the 11th September there is an additional train at 17:15 to Blackpool North, via Blackburn, please note this train does not go to Leeds but branches off at Hellifield. Also the 15:48 does go to Leeds but continues on to Nottingham.

While many benefit from the excellent Fellrunner service in the area, now it is summer our station enjoys its only direct bus service the 888 Newcastle to Keswick via Penrith run by Wright Coaches of Alston. The return at the station is Mon-Sat 17:15 to Newcastle via Alston and Hexham. The bus stops are at the end of the main station drive on either side of the road.
