As I'm writing this the period of Easter is coming to a close. And we are now heading to Pentecost. Pentecost could be classed as the birthday of the church where God blesses the church with his infinite wisdom through the gift of the Holy Spirit. All of this can seem a little far away to some people, it is interesting to think that the Holy Spirit on one hand can be this distant theological concept and yet on the other hand is the most intimate life-giving power that the universe has known. The same spirit that was hovering over creation when God started his mission, creating each plant, each creature and each of us. What does this mean to us today? I think we only have to go outside and look at how spring is now turning into summer and the trees are all starting to be covered with leaves filling our vision with breath taking shades of green to see the ongoing creative work of God.

There is a danger that some think that church is something that only happens in a building on a Sunday and that God the creator only has relevance in that building. But as I say we only have to go outside and lift our eyes and we can see that the spirit of creation is still very much there, very much unfolding in our lives if only we want to find or see Her (the Old Testament noun for the spirit is feminine – interesting thought).

It is so easy to forget creation around us, whether in people or in the beauty of all things. At this time of Pentecost I pray that we are more sensitive to the spirit of creation. In these troubled times I pray that She may give us a renewed sense of the beauty of God's creation and maybe even give us a little bit of hope, a little bit of light, a little bit of joy!

Herald June 1922

Mostly fine and warm (except on 23rd). Rain, 18th, soaked the annual Long Meg Service. Few swallows yet.

Addingham W.I. Fri 26 May, in Maughanby School, to help fund its autumn trip to Crofton Hall near Thursby, made £14 (now £1120)

Cricket: Warcop 82, Edenhall 59; Culgaith 50, Temple Sowerby 41; first this year (too cold till late May)

Langwathby and Edenhall W.I. met in the Long Room, Eden Hall, for a talk on Basket Making. Addingham W.I.'s ordinary meeting (mid-month), Wed, in Maughnaby School was on Skirt-Making

Culgaith's War Memorial was unveiled at 5pm by Col. T. Featherstonhaugh DSO on Sunday 25th. Carlisle St Stephen's Brass Band played before and after.

Carlisle Assizes, Stamper v. Schofield for grand: James Stamper, farmer Culgaith, bought a motor-lorry for his haulage side-line from Schofield motor dealer, Rochdale but it collapsed on first intake of 1000 bricks (3 ½ tons). The lorry was new in 1917 – Found for Stamper (Assizes tried the most serious local cases)
Derby Assizes jailed Toplis' busker for being loud.

Mr H.H. Bunker, farmer, Motherby was caught driving a car in Appleby when drunk. Fined £2 (now £160) and banned from driving for 3 months.

The Long Meg Service (began c. 1906) is often wet. This year they fled to the barn nearby. Lot there. When it's a fine evening, it's held inside the Circle, the singing led by a Penrith Brass Band.

Married in St. Andrew's, Penrith, by the Rector of Uldale, 3 June, Herbert G. Attwood, Chorlton-cum-Handy, near Manchester to Mary Taylor, Garth House, Little Salkeld.

Died at Winskill, 26 May, Annie, wife of Isaac Little, age not said; buried at Addingham, Mon 29 May
- at Chapel House, Hunsonby 18th, Mary, widow of John Metcalfe, Mount Pleasant, Hunsonby, 76
- at Melmerby, 30th, Esther, widow of Thomas Beatham, 69, buried at Melmerby

MEMO NEEDS ANOTHER TYPIST

What is involved?



You need to give up a weekend twice or, at most, 3 times a year. Articles come on a Friday and Memo needs to be ready for the printer by the following Wednesday. This gives time for the proof-reader to check everything and for any tweaks to be completed. Usually, our typists pass their finished draft to the proof-reader on the Sunday and it's all finished by the Monday.

What skills do you need?

We use Microsoft Publisher (which we'll provide) so you need a Windows computer and a printer. You'll be given the text and some of the images, but you'll be able to be creative with lay-out and clip-art. You will need to be able to use Publisher but we will give you clear guidelines and there will always be someone to call to get advice or guidance, and our proof-readers are brilliant at spotting slip-ups.
