

I am a keen parkrunner (if you don't know about parkrun just ask me!) and enjoy wild swimming as well as mountain 'bagging'. I also enjoy wandering round National Trust gardens, solving cryptic crossword puzzles and chatting to friends over tea and cake.

Whilst a southerner by birth and accent, I'm a northerner by choice, having made my home in Kendal until – much to my surprise – I felt called to ordained ministry. I gave up my job, left my friends and my church family, gave away my furniture, let my house out to tenants and moved to Durham to become a student again. It's been a big challenge, but also a great privilege and I'm delighted to be here, beginning to find my way around and meeting lots of friendly locals.

Help for farmers, by farmers: regenerative agriculture videos By Andi Chapple



UK farming is facing a perfect storm. Costs of inputs (for example fertiliser, pesticide and fuel) are soaring, weather patterns (and the climate) are changing and there is a new funding system for farmers to get used to.

You may have heard of 'regenerative' farming. It teaches us to see food production as integrated with nature and helps to build up local food systems. It can reduce inputs (and bring down costs), increase profitability and future-proof farm businesses. It suits upland livestock as well as market gardening and arable.

The Northern Real Farming Conference (NRFC) supports regenerative farming. With support from WWF-UK's Land, Food and Farming Fund, we have made a series of videos to help farmers research the approach. They show farmers talking about their experiences and offering concentrated practical advice on the profits and pitfalls of changing land management methods.

In 'Three Regenerative Farming Projects', Cumbrian farmers talk about how they have changed to 'rotational grazing' of sheep and cows - moving stock every day or two and letting the grass regrow - and how they now don't buy in feed or fertiliser and their farms are in profit. In 'Local Wool and Textile Production', you can hear about the stories behind new Lake District tweeds, a British wool database for weavers and knitters and yarn making from sheep local to the shop. 



Langwathby Church Renovation Fund's Sale of Work (3 stalls) and concert that evening, Thursday 27th July in the Reading Room, made £51-6s-9d (now £4104). The concert (Nurse Wilson in the Chair) included, "Come to the Fair" (Senior Girls); "Shipmate O'mine" (Mr. S Wood).

Cumberland County Council pondered the state of Langwathby Bridge's east approaches, now undercut by the river. Needs £50 to 'fettle' it (now £4000), no action yet.

Wednesday 3rd August was Langwathby and Edenhall WI's 2nd birthday. Mrs Nelson invited them to 'Stratheden' to celebrate it (business meeting, games, tea and a special birthday cake).

Mr W.G. Raine has worked in Glasgow G.P.O. these 37 years and now has just retired to Carlisle. He's on Edenhall land, the son of the late Mr. E. Raine, Head Gamekeeper for years to Sir R. G. Musgrave.
