

So even if I'm not very good at it, I'm going to keep trying to learn people's names. And in the meantime, there's always the gift of a smile, which is universally understood and doesn't rely on a great memory.

So let's keep being friendly and greeting our fellow villagers with a smile or a wave and - if you can - their name. That way, we'll brighten each other's day.

MEMO AGM 2023 Summary

The MEMO AGM was held at Langwathby Village Hall on Monday 6th February 2023. The MEMO Committee reported on the highlights of the year and expressly thanked the volunteers, advertisers & sponsors that have made 2022 a continuation of the MEMO's success.

2023 will be a financially challenging year for the MEMO. Despite the resumption of fees in 2022, following the waiver during the covid pandemic, our financial surplus remained worryingly low due to increased costs of production. Our fees have been increased for 2023 to start to address this and the MEMO committee is exploring other cost saving options as well as asking for support from our community if you feel able to donate any amount to help ensure the MEMO remains viable as a crucial community publication.

The existing committee members were re-elected, with the exception of our treasurer, with no other nominations having being received. Our treasurer Sheila let us know her intention to stand down after many years of supporting the MEMO and we thank her greatly for her commitment and support. Shelia has agreed to stay on while we find a new treasurer (see below).

The MEMO committee recognised the amazing contribution Alan Harryman, sadly now passed, made to the distribution of the MEMO for the residents of Culgaith for more than two decades. We also thanked those that stepped in to help with the distribution.




