At the moment, at Tullie House Museum in Carlisle, there is an exhibition of Pre-Raphaelite art based around the theme of the legends of King Arthur and his Knights of the Round Table.

This painting caught my eye. It's by Evelyn De Morgan and it shows Sir Tristan with his lover Isolde. That's them through the window in the distance. The story is that King Mark of Cornwall sent Tristan to fetch his bride Isolde over from Ireland, but somehow, they drank a love potion on the way and so tragically fell in love with one another. This painting, then, shows the sorceress mixing a love potion.

However, it's not all as pagan as it might at first seem.

Evelyn De Morgan has chosen her palette of colours quite consciously to give a hidden meaning. Black (the cat in the bottom right) stands for sin and ungodliness. There is a white towel behind the sorceress on the bench, and white stands for purity. To get to the purity, we need the red blood of Jesus, and there, on the tapestry to the left, are red lions (the "Lion of Judah" - Rev. 5.5). All of which leads us to the gold of her dress, which speaks of Divinity and holiness.

The woman in gold holds a chalice and is pouring something into it. Perhaps it's a reminder to us as Christians that the real "love potion" isn't something brewed up by witches. Instead, it's in the communion service with the bread and chalice that we are reminded just how much God loved the world and poured out his love, so that we ourselves can move from the blackness of sin, to one day be clothed in royal robes of righteousness. (Is. 61:10)

The exhibition at Tullie House is on until June 3rd. Well worth a visit! **Rev Dave**

Jeremy's breadth of interest in local affairs and wealth of knowledge are truly impressive. He contributes to other local publications, and is known as far off as the Island of Lewis, where his newspaper correspondence has led to changes in local regulations. He is also a very entertaining raconteur!

We are very grateful to Jeremy for his contributions to MEMO: he helps us to see our present from a broader historical perspective and has surprised many readers by his revelations about past family members.

To mark his service over so many years, and to express our gratitude, members of the MEMO committee met him in Penrith Library, where he conducts his weekly research using micro-films, and presented him with a small gift.

We really hope we can work together to help make Langwathby a nicer and cleaner place for us all to live in. Please can we **ALL pick up our litter!**


