How Langwathby Began

It began as a part of the empty woods between the fells and the Eden. A few people had lived hereabouts already, such as the person buried in the Kist (stone box) tomb's mound now called Robin Hood, on the Lang-



wathby side of Briggle Beck, just east of the footpath to Winskill. But the first group of settlers were Norsemen, farmers come from Ireland (land-shortage there) in small boats coming up the river. The woods were hard to travel in and full of hostile wildlife, such as wolves. How do we know this? From the placename 'Langwathby' which is Old Norse for farm-village next to the long ford. The ford is still there. It is a diagonal ford, long indeed, to the path up to Edenhall School.

The original village will have been at the ford's north end; not a big place (far fewer lived in England then). The old road descends the grassy field to it, in the hollow there. Until the bridge came in the late 17th century, this was the crossing place. There will have been an inn, for those using the ford, before or after their experiences in it.

But the peace and expansion and warm climate all came to an abrupt end in the early 14th century. The climate had become cold, dull, and wet. Edward I's attempts to add Scotland to his realm provoked the Scot's reprisals, for which the Eden Valley was a favourite route. Villages like Langwathby found themselves exposed to raiders. Dufton had the same problem (it was originally just East of Pusgill House near Dufton Pike) and hit on the same solution. Each village moved to a new defensible, its points of entry narrow and blockable, its green convertible to a cage for its livestock. In Langwathby's case, this was 200 yards north-west, on what may have been the common, and done by mutual consent or by order of the Lord of the Manor, who was by now the King (until circa 1300, since the 1240's it had been the King of Scots). Eden Straits is one of the narrow entries (strait means narrow). The church was included in the new village's layout. Langwathby's first written mention is in 1159 (tax-roll).

Edenhall's first written mention is in that year, too, in the tax-roll in London. Its placename shows that its first settlers were Anglos; they spoke Old English. Up the hill to south was the hamlet of Dolphenby, named after its original chief, one Dolfin, a Scandinavian. Its first written record is in the tax-roll (royal) of 1202, when the chief's name was Gilbert, an Anglican. Edenhall means village in the hollow near the Eden, in the dip between the church and the Hall. Later the Musgraves transported it to where it is now, circa 1680's.


