Rev'd Keith Speck continues to be our Methodist pastor and I, together with Rev'd Dave Milner, the Methodist superintendent, continue to be the joint mission community leaders. Committee members in attendance:Nigel Smith, Diane Steadman, Diane Marsh, Geraldine Gaizely, Bee Jones, Kate Pontin, Marylynne Winder. Members of the public: Vicky McIntosh and Sue Smith.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS.

Nigel Smith tendered his resignation as Chair of the committee which was accepted. Nigel was thanked for his many years of commitment as chair. Kate Pontin was elected as Chair as his replacement. The following committee members were re- elected unopposed:

Diane Steadman: Vice Chair Diane Marsh: Treasurer Geraldine Gaizely: Secretary.

The financial statement to the year end - March 31st- was produced by the outgoing treasurer Sandra Keown and was presented by Diane Marsh, the incumbent.

It shows an excess of spending over income during the last financial year of £112.29.(A full report of the financial statement is available on request.) The recent fundraising event - The Plant Fest- was very successful, both as a village community event and as a fundraiser . The committee members are very grateful to several local firms for their kind donations of raffle prizes and also to private individuals who also kindly donated.£1100 was raised and in addition an anonymous donation of £1000 was given by a local resident and a further donation of £50 was similarly given. In light of the success of this first such event it was agreed that it will become an annual occasion to be enjoyed by the village communities.

Whilst the total amount raised is a greatly appreciated sum of money, the costs involved with the maintenance of the Tarn as a public amenity are significant: they include Public Liability Insurance, the purchase and maintenance of essential equipment and its running costs and the purchase of plants and trees as they become necessary. Nevertheless, the donation of a strimmer by Mr and Mrs Mike Smith is greatly appreciated, not only because it is a cost saving but it also makes the rather onerous task of cutting back the grass a little less daunting.

There is an ongoing problem with water from the pond which floods the surrounding area and clearly this needs to be resolved as does the repair of the dry stone wall which has suffered some damage. Sue Smith kindly agreed to liaise with the Parish Council ,which oversees five village greens and church areas, to raise awareness of this particular issue and ascertain whether it should be further referred to Westmorland and Furness District council.

At the close of the meeting all in attendance were reminded that two chestnut trees have been planted at the edge of The Tarn in memory of Hugh Jago, whose years of work as Chair of the committee were greatly appreciated.
