

Other vanished villages in the MEMO's area Part 1

As well as Addingham, there are four more vanished villages, Dolphenby (Edenhall), Gawtree (Hunsonby), Maughanby (Addingham), Udford (also Edenhall's original site).

Dolphenby is first recorded in 1202, the 'by' shows that its first inhabitants were Norsemen, farmers who had come up the Eden by boat. Dolphen is a Scandinavian name still frequent in 12th to 15th century Cumberland. Fifty years ago,



if you visited it, a footpath led through the site, but the Estate has long since closed it. The village was small, on an east-west axis around a funnel shaped green, on the north side of the hill, about two-thirds up it. Its field was of grass. Nearby, to the north, is the Park Fence with a 19th Century footpath gate. Dolpenby Mill (or Edenhall's as well) has gone but the wheel's stone base survives in the small beck at the southernmost point of the 'Ladies Walk'. Dolphenby's grid reference is NY573316.



Dolphenby may have shrunk beyond viability due to the Scots raids, the Plague or better prospects elsewhere, but the final blow was the Estate's setting up the Park Fence, cutting across its open crop-growing field, making it too small to support life

The Fence may have begun as a Park Pale enabling the local deer to leap into the Park but not out again.

The modern farm of Dolphenby is two fields further up the hill to the south-east.


Culgaith Village Hall update - More dates for your diary!

As we age it is quite normal for us to slow down and 'take it steady'. But there's a difference between slow and stop. A difference that can be managed by the use of a range of techniques, gentle exercise and the use of a vast range of physical and mechanical equipment now available.

Many people are familiar with a walking stick but perhaps less aware of walking frames with wheels (**Rollator**), how to get the right one, the right size and the right advice.

Likewise, the thought of a mobility scooter might sound appealing but knowing which one is the right one is not always easy.

Fortunately, for people in this area, we have a shop in Penrith that can offer advice, **give demonstrations on a huge range of products**, and **offer** a hire service for scooters and wheelchairs.

Cowper's Mobility Centre have asked to advertise in THE MEMO but, as we don't take adverts from outside the MEMO catchment area we were unable to do so. Nevertheless the editorial team thought it would useful for people to know that such a shop exists.

And, in return for a donation to THE MEMO we have agreed to publish a one off notice, to raise awareness that **there is** a place where you can go to **for help**.


