**Melmerby Hall** (the manor house of Melmerby) began C.1300 as a pele tower, probably erected by John de Wigton, Lord of the Manor, who had noted the aftermath of the start of Edward I's Scots wars (1296) and wished to protect his property before the Scots came this way.

In 1315, Edward II ordered that the fort of Melmerby be provided with men and victuals and be safely guarded, as it commanded travellers on the old main road from Brampton to Appleby, a potential route for Scots invaders.

By 1322-3, John de Denum had 12 men garrisoning the tower. (Denum is a placename spelt here by ear. There are various Denhams in the south and also Denholme in the West Riding).

The Border had become quiet enough for gentlemen to extend their living quarters by a wing added to their tower, Melmerby's was added c1570. The pele was still there in 1677, but had gone by 1800, possibly when the present frontage was added in front of the 1570s hall in 1794, to look fashionable.

The pele, said tradition, was just north of the kitchen. Hiding the old house behind the fashionable new one was a local practice.

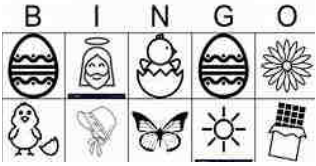

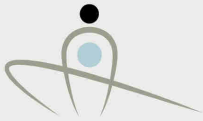
