

Melmerby (Part One)

Melmerby's first written reference (1201) calls it "Malmerby"; by 1240 it was "Melmerby", meaning "Melmor's bi". The "bi" implies that he was a Norse settler; the "Melmor" implies that he was an Irish man, as it means "Servant of Mary", i.e. the Virgin Mary. "Bi" later became "by", the Norse word for a farm-village. Gale Hall was a separate estate, first recorded in 1295. The main estate ("manor") was centred on Melmerby Hall, first recorded in 1322 as "the Fort at Melmerby", garrisoned by 12 soldiers. It is set between two deep ravines. Today its old wing dates from 1570, and the main frontage was built in 1794. The Threlkelds (originally from Threlkeld near Keswick) owned it from the late 14th century till 1694, when the last one married Thomas Patterson. His family held it till 1904, when the last (the Rev R. C. Patterson) died. He was the Rector of Melmerby 1843 - 1881.

The Rectors List begins in 1332. An earlier Rector Rolandus Threlkeld, Rector 1526 - 1565, lived in Melmerby Hall, a bachelor (in 1526 all clergy were, being then Roman Catholic) attended by 15 servants, all male, in uniform. He was also Rector of Lazonby, and built Force Bridge to be a shortcut, riding there every alternate Sunday for service. Force Bridge has gone, as has most of his road. He was a Squarson (Squire and Parson at once)
