MidEdenMemo



When I was a youth-worker, one of my favourite games to play was Jenga, the block building tower game, where you've to remove a block on your turn and add it to the top.

I think Jenga is a great analogy for how we interact with others. One negative or hurtful comment towards someone is all it takes for the tower to come tumbling down. And even if a person doesn't crumble, it can leave them full of holes. And yet it can take a long time to build a person up again, and it has to be done, brick by brick. And though each brick may not make that much difference to a person's life - the tower may not become that much taller - but after a while, and if we work together, we can build each other up to be bigger and stronger than before.

In one of the New Testament letters, James 3:5-6 says, "Likewise, the tongue is a small part of the body, but it makes great boasts". Consider what a great forest is set on fire by a small spark. The tongue also is a fire, a world of evil among the parts of the body. It corrupts the whole body, sets the whole course of one's life on fire, and is itself set on fire by hell.

So, in the world of turmoil we seem to find ourselves in, in a world that seems so full of words of hatred and violence towards each other, I ask you to join me in considering the words we use when we talk to others, and choose to use them for the good of each other, to build each other up, rather than to knock each other down.

Potential Church Closure

You are cordially invited to a public meeting to be held at **6:30pm** on **9th October 2025** at St Cuthbert's Church Edenhall to discuss the future of the church of Edenhall St Cuthbert.

This is a meeting to discuss the potential closure of the church as a Church of England church as a result of various external challenges being faced by parishes across the country, such as declining attendance and changing demographics.

We will be discussing options being considered by the parish that could result in the closure of the building and a change of responsibility for the church and churchyard, which may see it transferred to Edenhall Estate, who have kindly agreed in principle to take on the maintenance, responsibility and costs of the church going forward.

There will be an opportunity to hear the reasons for the proposals, to raise any questions or concerns, and to express views for consideration by the parochial church council of the parish of Edenhall and the Diocese of Carlisle in deciding whether and how to progress.

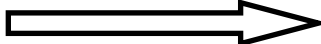
