### 'Anno Domini'

Every year there are anniversaries to remember. We have our personal anniversaries such as birthdays and weddings, but also national ones. This year we have been celebrating, amongst other things, the 200<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the birth of the modern railway (usually reckoned to be the opening of the Stockton and Darlington railway). Closer to home 2025 is the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the opening of the Settle-Carlisle railway line, one of the world's greatest journeys running through the Yorkshire Dales, emerging into the valley of the Eden and following the river closely on its way to Carlisle. 2025 is in fact the anniversary of the opening of the line to freight trains: the anniversary of the first passenger train ran in May 1876 and was a cause of rejoicing with many schools allowing children to see the first train.

2025 marks another less known anniversary. It is 1500 years since a Roman monk (Dionysius Exiquus) devised the calendar system we still use by designating years BC and AD. BC means 'Before Christ'. AD stands for Anno Domini, a Latin term which means 'in the year of the Lord'. In fact this is an abbreviation of the original phrase which translates as 'in the year of our Lord Jesus Christ'.

As you read these words we approach the turning of the year. We celebrate once again the anniversary of Christ's birth. We look back at the year just ending and remember happy times, and sad times. In a world of great uncertainty, it is reassuring to see the river Eden flowing through our valley, and to watch (or ride on) the trains which have followed the river for 150 years. And we look forward with hope and anticipation to the new year: the year of our Lord 2026.
