

What's in a Name?

Gamblesby was Gamelsby till the 1570s, as the Gamelsby near Wigton still is. It first appears as Gamelesby in 1177 and had belonged to Gamel, son of Bern, freeholders of the King, in 1130. Bern is probably the local version of the Old Norse name Bjorn. Gamel is the Old Norse nickname "Old Fella", common in the Baltic and Norse Ireland. Glassonby ("Glasson's farm", Old Norse) also belonged to the King's freeholder Glasson then.

Henry 1 took these lands (formerly theirs) and gave them to Hildred of Carlisle. "Gave" is what the deed says, but in practice Hildred will have paid a good sum for them.

Unthank had arisen just north of Gamblesby, by 1254. The name is Old English for a piece of land settled by squatters after an argument with the lord of the manor. They stayed put and he saw the chance to boost his income from adding them to his manor tenants. They will originally have been young lads of Gamblesby for whom there was no farmland, the village having expanded in the peace and stability of the 12th – 13th centuries. The weather was drier and warmer then. They went a little north and broke out on their own, still near parents etc, back home in Gamblesby.

Unthank was near the old main road (north to south route) from Brampton to Appleby, known as Appleby Street. Parts of it survive still, mostly as tracks only.


