



## Public Transport in 1922

No buses yet, other than from Penrith to Patterdale (since 1908) and from various hotels to their nearest station, or tourist coaches e.g. from Windermere.

For Langwathby there were the Midland Railway's steam trains (all trains were steam trains until c.1965 around here), five a day each way; none stopped here on Sundays. There were also the goods trains (not for passengers). Fares were cheaper pre the 1914 – 18 war. In 1922 they were still dear at 1 ½ d per mile (90p in 2026 money).



The Midland Railway's HQ was St. Pancras, a deliberately flamboyant show-off station in London. For timetable purposes, our bit of the line (the Settle and Carlisle) starts at Appleby, where expresses stopped too.
